Mayors Announcements/Updates:	Cllr Maxwell informed the meeting of an email received from the elections officer at Cumberland Council who stated that a separate election for Aspatria Town Council would have to be carried out and that a new notice of election would have to be published and the election date would be set within 35 days of 04 May 2023. Cllr Maxwell explained if Aspatria receive more nominations than seats an election will take place, however if the number of nominations is less the nominees will be elected uncontested. The meeting was informed that despite all relative parties being notified of changes to the website and email address, together with the Clerks address the nomination forms had not been received. They were sent to the Clerks previous address and not forwarded by Royal Mail.
